Ecology Survey



In recent months an ecology survey has been taking place at the proposed Kentbruck Green Power Hub site. An ecology survey aims to assess an area for valuable

plants, habitats and animals so that local planning authorities have the information they need to make an informed decision on whether the development would have an adverse effect on plants and wildlife in the area. The ecology report will be available early in the new year and will be placed on the website.

Orange- Bellied Parrott

The Orange-bellied parrot has been found in the region for

the first time since 1991! This is a very exciting find for our region. We had assumed presence of this species, but it was great to find it in its natural habitat. The bird is not expected however in the pine plantation where the project is to be constructed.



Planning

Biodiversity Report

We're currently seeking your input into a biodiversity report that outlines the results of the ecology surveys



into the local plants & wildlife that we have been ongoing over the past year. Your comments especially where you can provide additional information about biodiversity values in the vicinity of the project will assist us in preparing the next stage of documents in the Environmental Effects Statement (EES) process. The report is not final and is subject to further review in the EES process by the Technical Reference Group (TRG). The release of this document is distinct and sperate from the Department of Environment, Land, Water & Planning (DELWP)administered public consultation.

We would appreciate your comments by 4th of March to give our specialists time to address your input.
