Community Consultation Sessions

Portland, Mt Richmond & Heywood

The team from Neoen and representatives from UMWELT & DWELP held three community consultation sessions. These sessions we at Portland, Mt Richmond and Heywood. General discussions were mostly around the windfarm layout, environment and the transmission line.

Neoen Opens Portland Office

Feedback from the recent community consultation sessions showed that the community has concerns around if the project was on track and how and where they seek more information. Cultural Values Assessment

As part of our negotiations with the local Gunditjmara people we will be conducting a Cultural Values Assessment. A Cultural Values Assessment identifies cultural values,

interests, and associations with the project area or natural resource. It will also assess how the proposal might impact on the identified cultural values and may contain measures to mitigate the effects of the proposal. This will be done in partnership with Gunditj Mirring Traditional Owners Corporation and their Cultural Heritage department. The assessment will be conducted by independent consultants and will start in July 2022.

Cultural Heritage Walkover

On the 7th July, Gunditj Mirring Cultural Heritage Manager Adam Black, Cultural Heritage Officer Billy Bell, Garth Heron (National Manager), Kristina Yan, Kent Barker and Rob Hanssen from GTFP spent the day out on Gunditjmara country talking about the significance of Cultural Heritage on the proposed wind farm site. It was a great day to be on country and Neoen staff learned so much from the Gunditj Mirring team. Their understanding of the history of the area and what it means to mob was enlightening. We all walked away feeling richer for the experience and then visited the new Keeping Place and Aquaculture Centre at Tae Rek (Lake Condah).

Community Advisory Committee Meeting

We continue to consult with our Community Advisory Committee at quarterly meetings. With COVID-19 this has seen us often needing to meet via digital platform, but the feedback from these members of the community is invaluable.
